As a one-time exemption, in relaxation of Rule 55(9) of the Jammu and Kashmir Minor Mineral Concession, Storage, Transportation of Minerals and Prevention of Illegal Mining Rules, 2016, notified vide SRO 105 of 2016 read with S.O 137 of 2021 dated 16.04.2021, Director Geology and Mining, J&K is hereby authorized to the following:

- i. To seek applications from the interested successful bidders seeking extension in validity of LoI within 21 days from the date of expiry of LoI (31.08.2021) on the prescribed format forming Annexure to this Government Order.
- ii. To consider such applications as mentioned at (i) above submitted by the successful bidders seeking extension in validity of LoI on case-to-case basis for a stipulated time period that in no case shall exceed 03 months
- iii. To collect the remaining 50% bid amount from the successful bidder within 15 days of the extension in validity of LoI, if granted.


